

Locating Information in i3

There are several ways to locate specific guidance topics in the i3 website, with the basics illustrated below:

Categories and Sections on the Home Page

Users may scroll down the home page to see categories and subcategories - Early Intervention, Special Education, and Resources. Subcategories may be clicked on to locate relevant information. **Example:**



Headings and Drop-down Menus

Users may use the drop down menus of categories and sub-categories (Early Intervention, Special Education, Resources) to navigate to the desired guidance pages. **Example**



After navigating several pages into a tiered sequence, notice that there are "breadcrumbs" at the top of the page, where user's may easily click back to the previous pages. **Example:**



Search Function

The magnifying glass icon in the upper right corner may be used to enter keywords, to search for specific guidance topics. Typing in keywords will result in a display of pages that match the search criteria. **Example**:



Site Map

The link for the i3 Site Map can be used to access a listing of sections/links that are in a format similar to a table of contents. **Example - link at bottom of the home page**:
